

CITY CENTRE TOUR

Monday & Tuesday September 15 & 16, 10.30 - 13.30

Guided tour in the city centre of Göteborg. The guide will show you the most interesting spots of Göteborg such as: The Göteborg Opera House, the main street Kungälvsgatan with Götaplatsen where the Concert Hall and Art Museum is situated. The tour will cross several bridges with the beautiful scenery of canals. A coffee break will take place at the Göteborg Botanical Garden which in many respects, differs from most traditional botanical gardens on the European continent. The Garden was conceived and planned by the municipality of Göteborg in the 1910s as a botanical garden with an extra emphasis on horticulture and with a given place in Swedish community life.



The bus will leave outside the Convention Centre, entrance 8, at 10.30.

ISLAND OF MARSTRAND

Marstrand is a classical seaside resort with traditions from the 12th century and is perhaps best known for all the sailing boat races. Marstrand harbour nestles under the walls of one of the best preserved stone fortresses in northern Europe - majestic Carlsten Fortress built to protect the Swedes from the Danes in the 17th Century. The guide will walk you around the island and also take you to the fortress (the highest point on the island) to enjoy the fantastic panoramic view of the sea and the Island.

The bus will leave outside the Convention Centre, entrance 8, at 10.00.
